Requested Budget: 20,000 €– operational funds:

- 2023 Porto meeting (4000 €)
- A guest speaker to Porto (1500 € for flights and two night hotel)
- Guidelines and meetings (500 €)
- Promote collaborative projects (14,000 €): as per an open call for approximately 20 ongoing studies

- Additional comments on financial report:

In 2021-2022 the sum approved for the IBD WG was 6K; these funds were used to support the annual meeting (1,680) and research projects (4,320). An additional request for supporting other research activities (8,200; to a sum of 12,520 for research) was approved from the GIC budget.

For 2022-2023 we need to plan for higher expenses related to the Porto meeting (more attendants and no guaranteed industry support yet), so have requested 4,000, plus 1,500 for a guest speaker.

Given the increase in the number of active projects we are requesting a modest increase to 14,000, which we hope will be supported through GIC, if the budget for the IBD WG remains limited to 6,000.
